New Protocols

A. M419 Pediatric Sepsis

(B) either needs to be removed or have a pulse ox parameter added. Discussion on chart vs text vitals below chart (differences noted). Talked about removing the chart from specific protocols and adding it as a reference page for normal pediatric vital signs. Lauren Riney from CCHMC will work on this protocol and bring it back next month for approval.

B. SB201 ALOC/Syncope

Add the word *or* in between A. B. and C. for inclusion criteria. Definitions for inclusion criteria will be reformatted to the bottom of the top box. Joe Stoffolano to reformat and bring back to next meeting for final approval.

C. End-of-Life Care/Palliative Care

Will be looking at final educational PowerPoint, the state is looking to go live with this September 1st. Educational PowerPoint will be added to update education for 2020 protocols. Brian Doering.

D. OB and GYN

Discussion on instead of including TXA administration and dosing instructions, just add a reference for the TXA protocol for consistency. Then we can add post-partum hemorrhage to the inclusion criteria in the TXA protocol. Drug Sheets in reference will also need to be changed

for post-partum inclusion criteria. Decision to change Mag Sulfate dosing to *4-6* grams. Chief Gallo to make those changes to bring back for next meeting.

Protocol Updates/Revisions

A. O2 Administration

Dr. Calhoun referenced most O2 administration in protocol- more to come. SB203 and M400 specifically addressed and changed to <94% for both. These were changed to match the AHA recommendations. **APPROVED**

B. M410 Seizures

Removed eclampsia and pre-eclampsia from this section since it is now addressed in OB complications.

C. P612 Pain Management

Added (A) to state its ok for Tylenol and Fentanyl to be given concurrently (notes). Will also add generic names ex Acetaminophen and will add note about Tylenol and Morphine. **APPROVED with changes**

D. A105 and C308 inconsistencies

Dr. Calhoun presented changes to both protocols to make them consistent. **APPROVED**

E. M411 Toxicology

Local number put first in front of national number. The correct age for unintentional exposure in a pediatric patient is 12 years old. Also, changed language to reflect pre-dosed Narcan. **APPROVED**

F. M403 Asthma/COPD

Change dilution to 100 ml bag not 20 or suggested 50. **APPROVED with change**

G. Defib Dosing

Included recommendations from the manufactures to (J) and changed wording to state “manufacturers recommendations”. Discussion on to switch (B) to just state “DEFIB IMMEDIATELY” and add dosing below or just to keep it in the notes section. Dane to reformat and bring back for next meeting.

H. Trauma Triage

Now reflects 2019 changes. Shane Packer will just need to adjust ages in title of columns. **APPROVED with age change**

I. Epinephrine is being updated throughout entire protocol to reflect the correct labeling.

New Business

A. P610 Pediatric Seizure

O2 administration and capnography was added to section I to remind EMS personnel of the importance of these two things. **APPROVED**

B. Administrative protocol

A concern was brought up at the EDS committee meeting on the procedure for Medical Directors to add separate protocols not discussed in the protocol committee and whether the EDS committee needs to view and approve them. EDS decided they don't want to review for approval as the liability will fall back to the medical director, but will review for educational purposes and to see if it's something the whole group should be adapting. Language is being drafted to clarify this procedure.

C. New Mobile Stroke Unit

Dr. McMullan brought up UC Health's new mobile stroke unit. Still being decided where this unit will be located but we may need to adjust stroke protocols to include the unit's response.

D. Conflict with temperatures between pediatric drownings/submersions and hypothermia. Dr. Riney to review and suggest changes.

E. Admin note – some protocol numbers may change; looking at alternatives.
