NEW PROTOCOLS

Assault/Crime Scene/Trafficking

Dr. Charlton will bring a draft next meeting. Will be more generic about crime scene safety and preservation.

PROTOCOL UPDATES/REVISIONS

SB205 Hypotension/Shock – Changed to ALL ages- 1mcg but maintain 20 mcg MAX not 100 mcg as suggested. CCHMC fine with whatever decision on max dosing committee makes. Two lines – Adult dosing and Peds dosing. Consistency with ml and mcg? Convert peds to ml’s. CCHMC to clarify if 100 mcg’s is the max over a certain time frame. Do we need to add this is for long distance transports?

M419 Sepsis – “Sepsis Alert criteria met” - 1. IVF, then list pedi and adult doses. Include note about push/pull.

M421 Fever – Not clear on adult dosing, Chief Gallo reformatted to make clearer. **APPROVED.**

C304 Wide Complex Tachycardia –Removed Adenosine from J. Should we include note about- “this is included in ACLS guidelines but not here due to...” **APPROVED.**

PROTOCOL REVIEWS

A106 Do Not Resuscitate Orders in the Field – Rough Draft sent out to committee- follows state guidelines—Doering to send link for most current ORC. Will look up language on medical advisor.

A110 Highly Infectious Disease Transport – no report.

SB200 Clinical Practice Standards – Will bring back next meeting.

SB212 Guideline for Assessment/Transport of Pediatric Trauma <16 yrs. – Only change was change vitals to follow AHA PALS guidelines. Will need to reflect in other charts, Ken will update all. **APPROVED** with changes.

M404 Congestive Heart Failure – Added exclusion criteria, need to remove 6 from Medic section. D under ALL should be listed as 5. Other below to change to D, E and F. Should we include generic names under 5 as well. Nicole will send. Will bring back for final approval.

M406 Hyper/Hypoglycemia – Added full options for D50, D25 and D10. Discussion on should we make a recommendation for D10 over D50, issues arise with shortages with D10 vs D50. Agreed to make a note about D10 preference and make D50 secondary preference in Appendix. Stoffalono will add and bring back to next meeting. Ken will also take back to CCHMC to make sure they approve.

M408 Restraint Protocol – Discussion on chemical vs physical, DOT recommendations, and possible changes in Ohio law regarding pregnant females. Discussion on adding note about patient must be restrained with purpose made restraints and easily removed. Also, discussions about Versed vs Ketamine for excited delirium, do we need to look at adjusting Versed dosing?

M409 Allergic Reaction – no report.

M417 Adrenal Insufficiency – no report.

M418 Hyperkalemia (Skinner) –Removed F. Added calcium chloride dose to mirror the arrest dose. Change particulate to precipitate. Will remove 2 minutes administration for calcium chloride. **APPROVED.**

S502 Major Burns (Thermal or Electrical) – C- Added note for suspicion of CO poisoning, O2 administration. Major burns should all get fluid bolus not just for hypotension or hypovolemia. Rule of 9’s chart added for reference. Should add chart for pedi due to Rule of 9’s only for adults. Will add link back to M411. Will bring back with changes for approval.

P603 Pediatric Bradycardia – no report.

P608 Pediatric Hypoglycemia and Hyperglycemia - no report.

P617 Pediatric Psychiatric Protocol – no report.

P618 Pediatric Restraint Protocol – no report.

T703 Emergency Use of Central Access Device (CVAD) and Fistula (Johann) – Changed cleanse to scrub for 15 seconds. Will revisit.
